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INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/CAREGIVERS

Dubbo Wellington Small School's Athletics Carnival Friday, 6 July 2018

WHERE: Barden Park Dubbo (Corner Macleay St & Gipps St North Dubbo).

START TIME: All students will need to be at the oval by **9:00 am**.

The March Past will be at **9:15am**. Other events to begin at **9:30am**

FINISH TIME: The carnival will finish at approximately 2:30pm. All children will need to be collected from Barden Park at this time.

POSTPONEMENT:

Listen to 2DU from 7:00am onwards if the weather is wet and the carnival has to be postponed it will be school as normal.

We do not know what the back-up date for the carnival is – we will get this information to you if needed.



UNIFORM:

All children are to wear school sports uniform. Children need to be prepared for a range of weather conditions and this includes wearing sunscreen.

Shoes are to be worn at all times.

Very short synthetic track spikes may be worn for 100m, 200m, relay, long and high jump events.

ENTRIES:
