## Shuffling the Deck Chairs

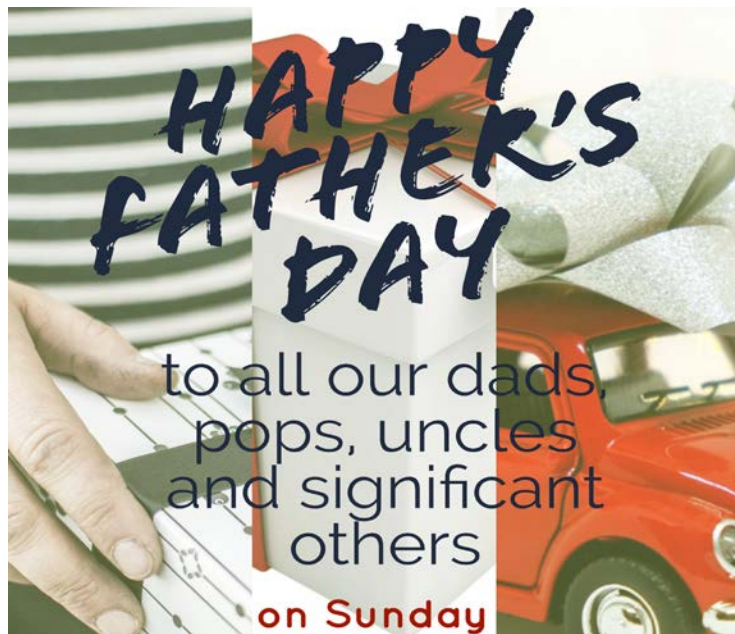
