Lunchboxes

Over the past week an increased number of students have been eating their lunch before school or at recess time or not packing anything at all. 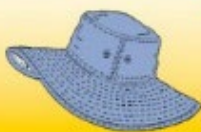
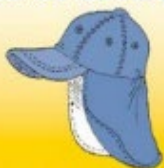
