This is very important leading up to the end of the school year, so please read the letters or contact Mrs Dunn.



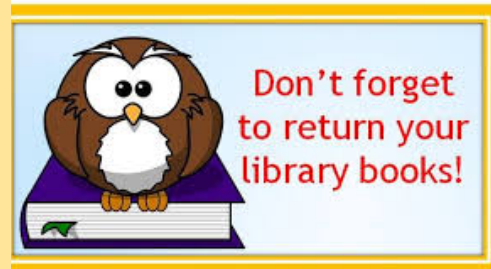
