## Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Caregivers

### Uniform

Wearing school uniform is a school expectation. Some students are attending school out of uniform and without the necessary equipment. The expectation is for all students to be in full school uniform each day whether it is the daily uniform or sports uniform. Please support our uniform policy and send your child ready for their daily routine. We have a wonderful uniform pool and shop run by the P&C where most uniform requirements are available. If there is a problem with uniform please send a note to your child's teacher. It is important to be proud representatives of Wongarbron Public School.

### Hair

Please ensure long hair is tied back and away from the face to minimise the risk of head lice. The fact is:

- head lice are one of the most commonly reported health complaints from parents and teachers
- anyone can catch head lice regardless of their age, sex, or how clean their hair is
- head lice move from one person's head to another via direct contact with the hair
- head lice do not survive long when they are off a human head
- head lice do not live on furniture, hats, bedding or carpet
- head lice have built up some resistance to head lice treatments

### Technology

Technology and sensible, safe usage is extremely important. Please follow or at least take on the following tips. Let's all be safe users together.

- Keep digital screens out of the bedroom and use an alarm clock instead.
- Ensure children get enough sleep. 9-11 hours rest per night is recommended for school age children, dropping to 8-10 for teenagers 14 years and over.

- Follow age guidelines for the use of video games and social media, such as the 12+ guide for Fortnite: Battle Royale and the minimum age of 13 for a Facebook profile.
- Establish technology free times in the home, possible around greeting times, meal times and in the evenings.
- Distractions such as TV and smartphones during student and homework sessions.

### Health Care Plans

If you have indicated on your child's enrolment form, on an excursion consent form or to your child's teacher that your child has a health condition which may require support at school or when involved in school activities, for example, a school excursion we need information from doctors to ensure we keep your child healthy and safe at school. If your child has any of these health conditions can you please provide the school with an up-to-date plan of action.

### Arborist

Over the coming weeks and during the holidays the trees around the school are going to be having the deadwood removed from them and be trimmed from buildings to prevent gutter issues.

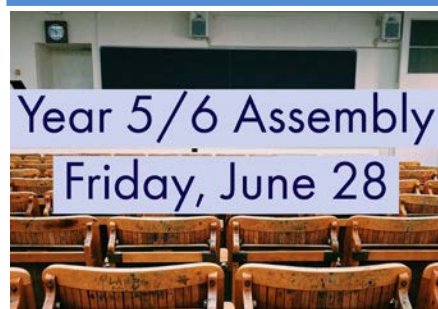
