
It was unfortunate for our community and school that on their

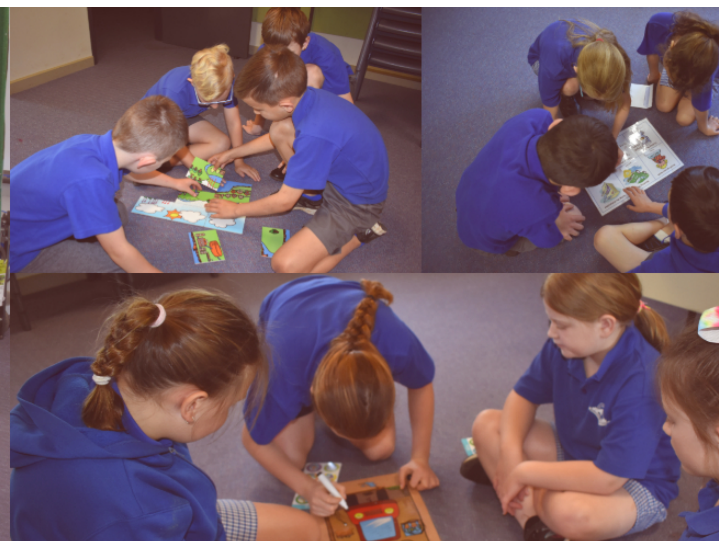
