## Cooking classes



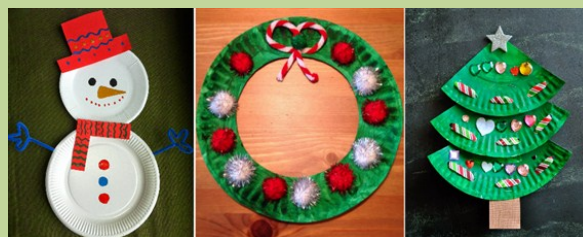
Next Monday and Tuesday each class will be having cooking lessons with the assistance of 'Master Chef', Houieda Garling.
